# **Rules & Regulations for The Conduct of The Show** AGRICULTURAL SECTION

- Sheep and cattle must belong to and have been in the possession of the Exhibitor for at least one calendar month previous to the show, except where otherwise provided, and all ewes must have nursed a lamb up to 1st August of the year of the show.
- No animal will be allowed to compete in more than one class except for Special Prizes or where otherwise provided.
- 3. All exhibits of stock to be forwarded by 9.30 am at the latest. They may not be removed before 3.00 pm, Poultry 4.00pm.
- 4. Only First Prize Animals eligible for Champions except where otherwise stated.
- 5. Bulls must be secured by a ring in the nose, with a rope or chain attached. All bulls when paraded to have two attendants.

#### INDUSTRIAL AND HORTICULTURAL

- 6. All work in the Industrial Section must be the bona-fide work of the Exhibitor. Sewing and knitting must be shown unwashed and must have been completed at a date later than last preceding Show.
- 7. Jams and Jellies to be shown in glass jars.
- 8. All Scones to be baked the day before the show.
- 9. All Exhibits entered in the Horticultural Section must have been grown by the Exhibitor or under his or her management.
- 10. The Committee reserve the right to inspect the gardens of all entrants in the Horticultural Section before the day of the Show.
- 11. Unless otherwise specified, Cut flowers to be shown with own foliage only.
- 12. All staging cards or labels must be securely fixed to the exhibits.
- 13. No one except those officially retained will be allowed in marquees during the judging.
- 14. All Exhibits (Home Industries) to be staged by 9.30 am on the day of the Show. Marquees will be open for staging from 8.00 am. They may not be removed before 4.30 pm and ONLY ON PRODUCTION OF THEIR REMOVAL CARDS.
- 15. All Exhibits (Horticultural) to be staged by 9.30 am on the day of the Show. Marquees will be open for staging from 8.00 am. They may not be removed before 4.30 pm and ONLY ON PRODUCTION OF THEIR REMOVAL CARDS.

#### GENERAL

- 16. All Classes will be Open unless otherwise stated.
- 17. All Exhibits are at Exhibitor's own risk and although every possible care will be taken, the Committee will not be responsible for any loss of, or damage to Exhibits.
- **18**. Exhibits in the Gift Classes and other Exhibits specially gifted by Exhibitors will be auctioned after the Show for the benefit of the Society's funds. Staging Cards where used should be marked accordingly.
- 19. Should any infringement of the Rules take place, any prize won by the Exhibitor concerned will be forfeited.
- 20. In no case shall a prize be awarded unless the Judge deems the Exhibit of sufficient merit. Where two or less than two Exhibits are present in any class, prizes may be awarded at the Judges' discretion. No Third Prize will be awarded unless there are five or more entries in any particular class but points will be awarded towards Special Prizes.
- 21. Any protests or objections must be in writing and in the hands of the Secretary not later than 3.00 pm on the day of the Show, together with a deposit of £5. The parties concerned must furnish all evidence and information required by the Executive Committee, whose decision will be final. The deposit shall be returned to the objector unless the Executive Committee consider the protest or objection to be frivolous, in which case it shall be forfeited. If the protest or objection is sustained the Judges' decision shall be overruled and the prizes shall be dealt with in such a manner and awarded to such Exhibitors as the Executive Committee may determine.
- 22. The decision of the Judges, subject to the provision of Rule 21 shall be final.
- 23. All trophy winners are liable for insurance of trophies for the custody of one year.
